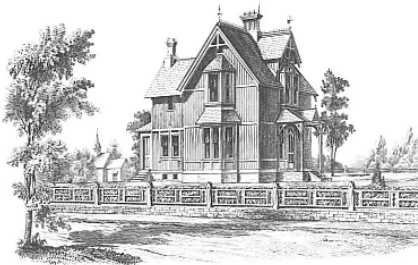
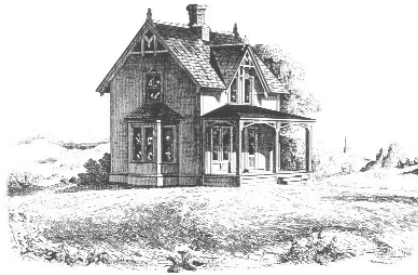

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insurance...

All **RHINO** inspectors are completely insured with Errors and Omissions, General Liability, and Workers Compensation insurance. General Liability insurance protects you should the inspector damage an item while performing the inspection. Workers Compensation insures the inspector against injuries while working at the property on your behalf. Errors and Omissions insurance covers any negligence by the inspector.

These insurances should not be confused with post-purchase homeowner warranties. Any system in a house could experience a normal mechanical breakdown after occupancy is taken.

consider before the inspection...

- ensure that all utilities are turned on for the inspection.
- review your purchase contract. Most contracts allow 10 days for inspections to be completed, so schedule your inspection promptly.
- mortgage companies usually require a wood destroying insect (WDI) inspection. Inquire if the home has ever received any WDI treatments. Are there any WDI warranties still in effect, and if so, are they transferable to new owners?
- the EPA recommends that every home be tested for Radon. If you require a radon test, ensure that the house is closed up, except for normal entering and exiting, at least 12 hours prior to the inspection.
- we suggest you clear your schedule so you can attend the inspection. The information you gain will be of great benefit.
